

Glogster Project

Using Glogster, students will explain the significance of a historical figure/event from American History.

1. Find out as much information as possible about your historical figure/event and why they are important to American History.
2. Create a Glogster account at <http://www.glogster.com/>
3. Following the guidelines on the attached rubric, display the historical information that you learned.
4. All information and images on your Glogster should be professional and reflect the historical significance of the person/event you researched.
5. Students are encouraged to use the “US History Resource Center” on the Media Center Webpage. It can be found under the “Collect” tab on the left side of the screen.
6. You will have three days in class to work on this project.
 - a. Wednesday 9/22: Research and create account
 - b. Thursday 9/23: Begin developing you Glogster
 - c. Monday 9/27: Complete your Glogster. You are expected to finish your project outside of class if you do not finish in the time allotted.
7. This project will count as a test grade.
8. Your project is due on Wednesday, September 29, 2010.
